During the process to reschedule Transportation Security Administration (TSA) records for media neutrality, it has come to the attention of the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) that TSA was unable to locate records that are currently scheduled as permanent under the disposition authority N1-560-04-012, Item 6: Intelligence Briefings, Speeches, Addresses and Comments.

In accordance with 36 CFR 1230.16(b), NARA requests that you respond within 30 business days and provide us with the following information:

- a description of the records, including the dates that the records were created and approximate volume of the missing records;
- a description of the office that created and maintained the records;
- a statement of the safeguards established to prevent further loss of documentation; and
- all details of the actions taken to salvage, retrieve, or reconstruct the records.
