The National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) has become aware of a potential unauthorized disposition of Bureau of Prison (BOP) records. Multiple news sources reported that surveillance video footage shot from outside Jeffrey Epstein's jail cell at the Manhattan's Metropolitan Correctional Center (MCC) was deleted or otherwise inaccessible.

As the Records Officer for BOP, NARA requests that you investigate this potential unauthorized disposition and submit a report to NARA within 30 calendar days. If an unauthorized disposition has occurred, please submit a report compliant with 36 CFR 1230.14. If no unauthorized disposition has occurred, please identify how these records are managed in accordance with the applicable records schedule item.
