Dear Corey Wells,

The National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) received the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) report of unauthorized disposition dated May 10, 2022. This report indicated that on November 4, 2021, two boxes of FY 2016-2017 hardcopy fire incident records from the Boise, ID District were presumed missing and after an extensive search could not be located.

NARA acknowledges that some information from the missing records are available on an interagency electronic information system, and that BLM has established additional administrative and physical control measures, including digitization of similar records, to prevent future loss of agency records.

Based on the information provided, the reporting requirements of 36 CFR 1230.14(a) have been met and NARA considers this matter closed. I appreciate your attention on this matter. If you have any questions or wish to discuss further, please contact me at laurence.brewer@nara.gov.
