The National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) has received your agency's report notifying us that one box of records consisting of files from two different boxes (5 and 32) from accession PT-118-2019-1446 went missing via shipment back to the Dayton FRC via FedEx.

We understand that the lost information consists of records from US v Randall R. Fletcher Jr (DC 2;09_CR-00082, 7th Cir. 12-3104) appeal file, dates consisted of September 13, 2012, through August 14, 2014, and that EOUSA believes that over 50% of the files can be reconstructed.

Based on the information you have given us, we consider this matter resolved. If this record is located, please let us know so we can update our records.
